A standard shower can use up to **20 litres** every **minute!**
That accounts for up to **24%** of household water use!

Shower Tips

- *Install a water-efficient shower head. A WELS Scheme 3-star rated shower head will use no more than 9 litres of water per minute.*
- *Take a shorter shower. Shorter showers not only save water but help reduce the amount of energy associated with heating the water. Insulate your hot water pipes. This means you won't need to wait as long for the hot water to flow through—saving you both water and energy.*
- *Make sure your hot water system thermostat is not set too high. Use a bucket to catch water while the shower warms up. You can then reuse this water on your garden.*
