

It's time to be water wise because every drop counts



Did you know?

One garden sprinkler can use up to **1,000 litres** in only **an hour!**

That amount **rivals or exceeds** what an average household should be using in **an entire day!**

At current Level 2 restrictions, the water conservation measures for watering of private gardens are:

- *Odd-numbered houses can use sprinklers on Tuesdays and Saturdays between 6am & 7am and 6pm & 7pm.*
- *Even-numbered houses can use sprinklers on Wednesdays and Sundays between 6am & 7am and 6pm & 7pm.*
- *No watering of gardens by trigger nozzles or sprinklers on Mondays.*
- *Hand-held hoses with a trigger nozzle can be used at any time on any day except Monday.*
- *Watering cans and buckets can be used at any time.*
