## REGISTRATION DEFINITIONS AND INFORMATION

### Pensioner Concession

Pensioner fees apply if you hold a Pensioner Concession Card or a Repatriation Health Card (Gold).

### Approved Working Dogs (no charge)

Working dogs meeting the criteria specified by the *Animal Management (Cats & Dogs) Act 2008* i.e. dog kept on rural land for the purpose of droving, protecting, tending or working stock; by an owner who is a primary producer or a person engaged or employed by a primary producer. **Working dog checklist required.**

### Accredited Assistance Dogs (no charge)

Includes guide dogs, hearing dogs & any other types of accredited assistance dogs. Handler must hold a current "**handlers identity card**" issued by the Department of Communities, Child Safety & Health Services for an assistance dog & the dog is to be **certified as an assistance dog.** **Copy of certification required.**

### Young Dogs under 3 months (no charge)

It is recommended to register your puppy (under 3 months) at no charge. If your puppy goes missing, Council can reunite you.

### Rural Dogs (fees apply)

Dogs kept on rural land that are not bonefide (with appropriate documentation) "working dogs" or "assistance dogs" are required to be registered.

### Registration Transfer

Balance of remaining registration for animal deceased may be transferred to a new animal for the remainder of the current registration period on payment of nominal fee (replacement tag).

### Deceased animal

Owner must provide adequate proof such as euthanasia certificate, letter issued by a Vet or Statutory Declaration.

### Reciprocal Registration

Where an animal is currently registered with another Local Government within Australia and proof of the registration is provided to CCRC, that animal will be registered at no charge (except for a tag issue charge) for the remainder of the current registration period. An animal that is only registered on a Micro-Chip database does not qualify for Reciprocal Registration.
