

COMMUNITY COMPOST PROGRAM

The Cassowary Coast Regional Council would like to make composting easier and are offering a rebate of \$20 for compost bins and worm farms.

Application Form: Compost bin/worm farm rebate

If you are a resident of the Cassowary Coast Region and have purchased a compost bin or worm farm after 12 October 2015, all you have to do to claim your \$20 rebate is:

1. Complete this application form by providing the information requested on the back of this form;
2. Attach your tax invoice for the compost bin/worm farm;
3. Return the completed form and tax invoice to Council either:

When you return your completed form and invoice to Council in person, we will refund you the \$20 on the spot. When you return your completed form and invoice to Council by post or email, make sure you have included your bank details where requested on this form and we will deposit the \$20 into your nominated bank account. Also include your mailing address and we will post a composting information pack.

A composting information pack will be provided to you with your \$20 rebate to support use of your compost bin or worm farm.

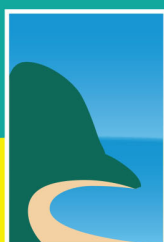
Terms and conditions

Only one rebate is available per household. The compost bin or worm farm must have been purchased after 12 October 2015, with the purchase date and item purchased evidenced by a valid tax invoice. Please note that EFTPOS receipts are not acceptable as proof of purchase. This rebate is only available to residents of the Cassowary Coast Region, which means persons who own and/or occupy a property in the Cassowary Coast Regional Council local government area. Proof of residence is required with your application (such as a photocopy of a utility bill in your name). The rebate will total \$20. If the purchase price of the compost bin or worm farm is less than \$20, the rebate will be for the purchase price of the compost bin or worm farm. The rebate is not available for materials to build a DIY composting or worm farming system.
