



# WELCOME TO Tully WASTE TRANSFER STATION

**Tully Waste Transfer Station** is the main solid waste handling facility for waste and recyclable materials in the Tully region. Council is committed to minimising waste being disposed to the landfill and encourages responsible waste practices.

Segregating and recycling waste materials is an extremely important activity and recyclable drop-off points are provided at this facility. Please refer to the attached site map for location of drop off points, look for signage or speak with site staff.

Whilst Council owns and maintains this facility contractors are engaged to supervise daily site operations. CCUS operate the

gatehouse and weighbridge whilst Mams operate the Transfer station and landfill.

An environmentally engineered landfill approximately 1 km west accepts dry type waste only within specially constructed landfill cells. Wet waste is temporarily stored at the Transfer Station for daily transportation to the Springmount Landfill near Mareeba.

This leaflet provides important information to assist you in using this facility safely. Please take a moment to read it carefully and keep it for future reference.

# FACILITIES

## Recycling:

Recyclables collection points are provided for:

- Container Refund Scheme (CRS) eligible mixed plastics, aluminium and glass
- Cardboard
- Ferrous metal ie whitegoods, galvanised iron (including light and heavy steel)
- Green waste
- Non-ferrous metals (aluminium, copper, and brass)
- Used automotive engine oil
- Tyres (fees apply)
- Clean and empty chemical containers (DrumMuster program)
- Fertiliser bags
- Car bodies fully drained of oils and fluids as per checklist
- Automotive wet/dry cell batteries
- LPG gas cylinders (fees apply)
- E-waste
- Mattresses (fees apply)

Recyclables are temporarily stored on site for collection by recycling companies. It is important that recyclable materials are separated from general waste and placed in the correct designated storage areas as contaminated products cannot be recycled.

## Greenwaste:

Greenwaste is collected at the Transfer Station and processed into mulch. Disposal is free to the public, however charges apply to commercial operators.

## Tip shop:

A tip shop operates on the site as a further means for recovering unwanted items. A range of second hand goods are available for purchase at low cost. Please see the staff on site for more information.

# SITE ENTRY CONDITIONS

CCRC aims to provide a safe facility for use by all within the community and takes yours, ours and our site contractors safety very seriously. Site operations and conditions are hazardous, hence your cooperation is requested.

## Site entry conditions are as follows:

- Compliance with signage and requests of site staff is mandatory at all times
- Please wear suitable enclosed footwear
  - Bare feet, thongs or sandals are not permitted
- Children must be supervised at all times
- Smoking is prohibited on site
- Animals must remain in vehicles at all times

## Domestic waste entry to transfer station:

- stop at the "Stop" sign outside the weight bridge station's office
- wait for your load to be checked by on site personnel
- wait until personnel authorize entry and provide disposal instructions
- proceed slowly to designated area

## Commercial waste entry to transfer station:

- wait for weighbridge clearance
- allow for on site personnel to direct you on weighbridge
- make transaction
- wait until personnel inspect your load, authorize entry and provide disposal instructions
- proceed slowly to designated area
