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Part 1 Preliminary

1 Short title

This subordinate local law may be cited as *Subordinate Local Law No.2 (Animal Management) 2022.*

2 Purpose and how it is to be achieved

- (1) The purpose of this subordinate local law is to supplement *Local Law No. 2* (*Animal Management*) 2022, which provides for prohibitions, regulation and management of **animals** within the **Council** area.
- (2) The purpose is to be achieved by providing for schedules referred to in the local law of:
 - (a) the circumstances in which the **keeping of animals** is prohibited;
 - (b) the circumstances in which keeping of **animals** requires a **permit**;
 - (c) the circumstances in which desexing of an **animal** is required;
 - (d) specific standards for **keeping of animals** of a particular species or breed;
 - (e) breeding of **animals** that does not require a **permit**;
 - (f) the exclusion of **animals**, or **animals** of a specified species, from **public places**;
 - (g) designated dog off-leash areas;
 - (h) other local governments or organisations able to accept impounded **animals**;
 - (i) the conditions to be complied with by persons who offer **animals**, or a particular species of **animal**, for sale; and
 - (j) the designation of **conservation planning areas**.

3 Authorising local law

- (1) The making of the schedules in this Subordinate Local Law is authorised by *Local Law No. 2 (Animal Management) 2022.*
- (2) At the head of each Schedule there is a reference to the relevant authorising Local Law section.

Part 2 Repeals

4 Repeal

This Subordinate Local Law repeals -

(a) Subordinate Local Law No.2 (Animal Management) 2011

Schedule 1 - Prohibition on keeping animals

Section 4 Local Law No.2 (Animal Management) 2022

1	Dog	Keeping more than 3 dogs is prohibited on a premises . Keeping more than two (2) dogs is prohibited on a premises in a Conservation Planning Area.

6	Stock	Keeping stock is prohibited on a premises less than 8,000m ² .	
7	Bees	 Keeping non-native bee hives closer than 15m from a neighbouring residence or place of public access is prohibited. 	
		2 Keeping more than 1 hive on a lot less than 800 m ² is prohibited.	
		3 Keeping more than 2 hives on a lot less than 2,000 m^2 is prohibited.	
		4 Keeping more than 8 hives on a lot less than 10,000 m ² is prohibited.	

Note: The application of Schedule 1 (Prohibition on Keeping of Animals) does not apply to **premises** where a **development approval** pertains to the use of **premises** for animal husbandry.

	(a) without nuisance; and	
	(b) if a code of practice for the keeping of greyhounds has been approved by the Greyhound Racing Authority of Queensland—in accordance with the requirements of the code of practice.


