Innisfail's iconic Geraldton Bridge will undergo a \$1.4 million facelift with the first stage of restoration commencing.

Geraldton Bridge connects the CBD of Innisfail with residents in Innisfail Estate, Flying Fish Point, and other nearby suburbs, with the scope of restoration to include cleaning, repairing concrete spalls, sealing and renewal of expansion joints.

With the project planning dating back to 2021, Council accepted the tender as submitted by RMS Engineering & Construction Pty Ltd for the body of works.

Cassowary Coast first North QLD council to investigate bypass system for coastal erosion

Recommendations and findings from the Cassowary Coast Rating Advisory

Committee (RAC) was published with community members invited to have their say.

The Rating Advisory Committee (RAC) was formed in June 2023 and was led by an independent facilitator to review Council's current rating structure, providing recommendations for future general rates. Cassowary Coast Regional Council will host a series of information sessions in March to discuss the RAC recommendations and answer questions submitted through the registration process.

Geraldton Bridge, Innisfail - temporary change to traffic conditions

Starting from Monday through Wednesday 7 February, the Geraldton Bridge Restoration Project will recommence.

In the interest of safety, a single lane closure will be in place from 6:00pm to 6:00am to facilitate works. Traffic will be maintained in both directions under traffic control, with minor delays anticipated.

Daytime operations are scheduled for the bridge walkway and footpath underneath the bridge on the Flying Fish Point Road side, ensuring full accessibility for vehicles and pedestrians remain in place during peak travel times.

Night activities will focus on areas previously inaccessible by barge, including sealing and concrete repairs of segments of the underside of the bridge.

We anticipate low noise levels during these activities, with the contractor committed to minimising noise impacts.

Blackman Road, Warrami Floodway Remediation Works

Recent weather conditions have caused a change in our projected timeline for the Blackman Road Floodway Remediation Works. Despite the challenges experienced,

our contractor has been back on site since Monday 8 January and the revised completion date is now end of February.

We will keep you updated on our progress and appreciate your understanding during the unforeseen weather-related delays.

Warrina Lakes Car Park Upgrade Back on Track After Rainy Roadblocks

After delays caused by TC Jasper and heavy rainfall, we are pleased to advise that our team are back on site as part of the Warrina Lakes Car Park Upgrade.

The new concrete path, which will run alongside the pump track and proposed nature play area, has been poured last week. When the weather permits we will be able to lay the asphalt and complete line marking. We are planning for works to be completed by end of January, subject to weather and site conditions.

The \$200,000 carpark upgrade project has been funded by the Queensland Government's Works for Queensland program.

Port Hinchinbrook (Cardwell) STP Temporary Change in Working Hours

As works continue for construction of the Port Hinchinbrook (Cardwell) Sewerage Treatment Plant (STP), safety remains our top priority. Due to the current heatwave conditions, there have been changes in the site working hours to ensure the health and safety of the site workers.

On Wednesday 31 January, Thursday 1 February, Monday 5 February and Tuesday 6 February works will commence from 2.30am.

On Friday 2 February, Saturday 3 February and Wednesday 7 February works will commence from 6.00am.

To minimise impacts for nearby residents, the contractor has implemented measures aimed at reducing noise levels. This includes only having essential staff on site during the earlier start times; and activities that produce loud noise such as cutting concrete blocks, are planned for regular site hours. Mains powered lighting will be utilised, to eliminating the need for generator-powered lighting.


