13. Part A Siting dispensation for front boundary – Performance criteria as stated in the Queensland Development Code MP1.2 (lot over 450m²)
P1 The location of a <i>building</i> or <i>structure</i> facilitates an acceptable streetscape, appropriate for – (a) the bulk of the <i>building</i> or <i>structure</i> ; and (b) the <i>road</i> boundary <i>setbacks</i> of neighbouring <i>buildings</i> or <i>structures</i> ; and (c) the outlook and views of neighbouring residents; and (d) nuisance and safety to the public.
