#### **Asbestos**

Asbestos should only be removed and transported by a licenced contractor. Where it is then to be brought to approved landfills with permission sort and granted a minimum of 2 business days prior. More than 175kg or 10 square metres will be required to have a <u>Waste Tracking Certificate</u>. Failure to give this notice or Certificate may result in transporters of asbestos being refused entry to site. This condition is in place to allow landfill operators to appropriately prepare disposal areas. Minimum fee applies for special waste burial.
